



PITTSBURGH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

APPLICATION FOR UNSOLICITED PROPOSALS TO THE ART IN THE AIRPORT PROGRAM

All requests for display of artwork, performances, or other arts events are reviewed by the Art in the Airport Program's Art Advisory Committee. The following materials must be submitted in proposal form to opa@pittsburghartsCouncil.org. For list of upcoming deadlines, please contact opa@pittsburghartsCouncil.org. All proposal materials must be zipped into one folder, and transferred via FTP sites such as Dropbox or Google Drive, please just include one link in your email. Individual files or incomplete applications cannot be reviewed.

PROJECT NARRATIVE

Please submit a project narrative outlining exactly what you are proposing to do, the process, what the end result will be, how long the project will be installed at the airport, and your plans for installation, removal, shipping, and maintenance.

PARTICIPATING ARTISTS' BIOS

Include up to one page biography of all participating artists or contributors. Artworks not designed by artists are not considered eligible for exhibition.

STATEMENT OF INTENT

Explain why you are interested in making this project happen at Pittsburgh International Airport. Outline why this work is unique and how it reflects the art and culture of the region.

PROJECT TIMELINE

Include estimated timeline of all project elements including installation and de-installation.

PROJECT BUDGET

Include your budget as applicable to installation, removal, shipping, insurance, maintenance, or other project fees.

PROOF OF FUNDING

The airport does not offer financial support to unsolicited projects at this time. Please provide proof of project support, or explanation of where funding will be coming from. Note that if your proposals include an event or an object on loan, you will be responsible for providing proof of insurance for all participants or art objects from transit, installation, display, and through de-installation.

WORKSAMPLES

Up to 10 images of proposed artwork including any scale renderings, descriptions, sizing, and materials. Keep all images less than 150 dpi please. Video under 90 seconds or links to video hosting sites may be included. Please also include information about the artist's past work including work samples or link to artist's website.
