Existing Environmental Contracts

On-Call Deicing Action Plan and Field Services Contract

- ACAA, under an existing PADEP Consent Order, is required to conduct water quality sampling associated with aircraft and airfield deicing/anti-icing activities that occur at the airport. This contract work includes all manpower, equipment and analysis needed to complete these requirements. It also provides the mechanism for preparing the report (Deicing Action Plan Update) which details all of the information generated from the sampling and analysis as well as aids in the development for the upcoming years Deicing Action Plan.

On-Call Environmental Planning, Engineering and Management Services Contract

- The general scope of the work includes: air quality permitting and reporting, and recordkeeping; hazardous and residual waste reporting; Environmental Management System (EMS) upgrades; assistance with preparation of Emergency Action Plans for regulated dams on airport property; Stormwater Pollution Prevention Planning; Integrated Contingency Plan (ICP) updates/upgrades; regulatory review; Aboveground and Underground Storage Tank Inspection Services; Stormwater Management Plan updates; and, Wetland Delineations/Investigations.

On-Call Environmental Services Contract

- The general scope of the work for this contract consists of on-call environmental engineering, consulting and field services for both Pittsburgh International and Allegheny County Airports, to include project, routine, and 24-hour emergency consulting, investigation, inspection, monitoring, sampling, analysis, recordkeeping, reporting, and other tasks necessary to ensure ACAA's compliance with regulatory requirements.
- The sampling is conducted as part of our existing National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit which covers the industrial discharges from the airport.
- Additional sampling is associated with the consecutive water distribution system (airport drinking water system), the landfill monitoring wells, potential Asbestos-Containing Materials (ACM) and the 911th Outbreak.

Hazardous and Residual Waste Management Services Contract

- The general scope of work for this contract consists of providing necessary manpower and equipment to transport, store and legally dispose of, or recycle the different hazardous and residual waste streams that are generated by the airport. This contract also includes emergency response services which would be needed in the event of a significant spill or release.

Spent Deicing Fluid Recycling and Disposal Services

- The general scope of work for this contract consists of providing necessary manpower and equipment to transport, store and legally dispose of, or recycle all of the spent aircraft deicing fluid generated at the airport.
